What are the risks with frozen pipes?

When temperatures drop during winter, the excess water inside a pipe expands as it freezes. The expansion can cause a split in the pipe, leading to leaks when the water thaws. Frozen water pipes can burst due to increased pressure in the worst-case scenario.

Although properties are only likely to be unoccupied for a limited period as part of a robust risk management programme, the draining of the water system should become a key component of a close-down procedure, as the subsequent damage caused by water ingress can be considerable.

With 'escape of water' claims costing UK insurers millions of pounds every day, guidelines around draining a water system during a period of unoccupancy may vary between providers, so it is essential you understand what your policy stipulates, allowing you to make an informed decision.
